Unfinished Business

Water Filtration System Project – Continues to progress, we are ahead of scheduled. Pre-filters are due in November, Vessels are due in December. Dead line to have this project complete is May of 2024. West Saddle River Road Resurfacing Project – This project has been delayed, pushed back about a week. The contractor is falling behind on other projects prior to ours due to weather.

New Business

Ordinance #2023-89 this is on for adoption tonight - increase for permit parking fees.

Ordinance #2023-90 this is on for introduction - water rate increase approximately 4 ½% a quarter.

Administrator stated we have commitments not only for the water vessels for the purification project at a cost of 4 million dollars and we have almost equal amount over the next decade for our tank upgrades/maintenance.

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance #2023-89

ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 79 OF THE CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" (increase permit parking fees)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, that Section 79-18 of the Code **Permits** is hereby amended as follows:

Section I

- A. No change.
- B. The fee to be charged by the Borough Clerk for the resident permits shall be \$500.00 and businessman permits shall be \$100.00. No fee shall be required for permits issued to Borough employees for parking during the regular course of business in Municipal Lot B.
- C.-F. No change.

Section II

Repealer

All other provisions of this Ordinance which are not affected by this amendatory Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect. However, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this amendatory Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section III

Severability

If any portion of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section IV

Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.

"AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 81 OF THE CODE ENTITLED "WATER AND WATER RATES"
BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus that Chapter 81 of the code is hereby amended as follows:

81-21 Rates and Charges is amended as follows:

- (a) Effective January 1, 2024 all water taken or consumed shall be charged to consumers at the following rates:
 - (1) Seven dollars (\$7.90) per one thousand (1,000) gallons, with a minimum charge of Sixty Dollars (\$64) per quarter, or any part thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the Shared service agreement on behalf of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Service Agreement and approves the execution of the Service Agreement.

A motion was offered by Council President Troast and seconded by Councilman Policastro to approve Resolutions #23-110 thru #23-114. Motion carried on a roll call vote – All present voting "Aye".

LIAISON REPORTS

<u>Recreation</u> – Councilman Iannelli reported fall sports are coming to a conclusion, winter sports registration is now opened.

Library – Councilman Policastro reported in 2024, the Library's One Third Mill is increasing to \$536,158.00.

This is an increase of \$41,115.26 over 2023. Circulation in September was 11%lower than August but 3%higher than last year.

<u>Board of Education</u> – Councilman Policastro reported on October 18th the Ho-Ho-Kus and the Borough joined together for a Cornhole Tournament to raise awareness for the Stigma-Free Initiative. The HHK Fire Department visited the School to speak with the 5th graders about fire safety during October's Fire Prevention week. The Duffield Hall construction is underway. Photos of the progress are available on the School website. The School will be closed November 9th & 10th for the NJEA Conference.

<u>10 Orvil Court Improvements</u> – Councilman Policastro reported, As I reported last month, the Mayor & Council is still in the process of evaluating the study findings and recommendations and is in active dialogue and negotiations with the Library Board of Trustees. We hope to have a resolution by the end of the year at which point the public will be duly informed.

<u>Ambulance Corps</u> – Councilman Crossley reported one of their rigs have been in for repairs for a blown gasket for two weeks now and could be another two weeks. With the help of our President Carol Tyler, she found two buyers for two stretchers that they did not need anymore. Sold for \$3,500.

<u>Shade Tree/Beautification</u> — Councilman Crossley reported they planted the (4) trees on Sheridan, Sheridan is now complete. At Borough Hall all the shrubs, sod, new lighting & Rusty Thompson tree is done and all the plaques are in place for the dedicated trees. Just waiting for a couple of more benches, and the sign, once they come in Phase 2 will be completed. He will be meeting with the committee before the end of the year to discuss Phase 3.

Fire Department — Councilman Shell read a statement into the record regarding the Fire Department matter "As the public may be aware the Governing Body has been dealing with a serious incident which occur at the firehouse and the aftermath of such incident. The Governing Body promised our residents with a full accounting once this matter had concluded. On October 17, 2023, Judge Suarez, sitting on appeal to the Superior Court of New Jersey, heard the matter and found Chief Scott McDermott guilty of the charges brought by the Governing Body. These included: Incompetency or Inefficiency or Incapacity of Performance, Infringement of Policies defined in the Personnel Manual or Failure to Comply with Department Rules and Regulations, Conduct Unbecoming, and Insurbordination. These were the same sustained charges and findings by Judge Toskos, who sat as a hearing officer below. Ironically, the Court reasoned that McDermott could not be terminated, not because of McDermott's actions, but because the Borough did not seek to discipline other members of the Fire Department. As a result, the Court imposed the original 30 month suspension of McDermott and took no position on his return as Chief. The Governing Body took no pleasure in addressing this matter, but was always concerned with the safety of our residents. Judge Suarez's decision reaffirms the Borough's commitment in this regard". Councilman Shell continued with his report, the fire Department had a very successful fire safety month, they visited all the schools informing them of fire safety. He continues to thank them for their service to the community.

<u>Chamber of Commerce</u> – Councilman Shell reported the Chamber came to him regarding an event they would like to do in conjunction with our annual Tree Lighting Ceramony and the luminary event. They would like all the Chambers businesses to stay opened later to encourage people to stay in town that night. A more detail plan to follow. <u>Police</u> - Police chief LaCroix reported the department assisted with the Halloween painting and Richards Run. In the past month they had issues with bicycles being stolen at the train station. Chief asked at the December Mayor & Council meeting he would like to recognized a couple of officers for some cases they worked on this year.

<u>DPW</u> – Jeff Pattman, DPW Supervisor reported they are gearing up for leave season. Councilman Shell stated he as some residents asking how to discard Styrofoam. Administrator stated he is in talks with the 13 northwest towns to set up a shared service agreement to purchase a device themselves. However, Oakland has a Styrofoam event coming up shortly and he will post on our social media sites.

MAYOR COMMENT

Mayor stated to the Council we are going to be losing the Judge come January, right now we have (3) candidates and asked who wanted to be on the interview committee to get back to him.

Administrator Jones stated we have a festival coming up on November 4, 2023, rain date of the 5th with local artists & craft people on the Town Green.

<u>CLOSED SESSION</u> - On a motion by Councilman Crossley, seconded by Councilman Shell, the Mayor and Council approved entering into Executive Session closed to the public. Motion Carried by voice vote – all present voting "Aye".
