## Carol Tyler, 1 Stouts Lanes

Ms. Tyler discussed the Bank of America Property – 10 Orvil Court. She feels moving the Ambulance Corp to that building would be a better use for that property than the Library. The town has the ability to address two very important issues. First issue is the fact that Ambulance vehicles have grown so large to accommodate all of the required necessary equipment that they barely fit in the current building. There is no way to improve the current situation as the overhead door frame cannot be expanded, the doors cannot be made any wider. As the 10 Orvil Court building stands now we would solve so many problems that have existed for far too long. It would meet our needs with just building a garage where the current drive through portion stands. We already purchased smaller boxed size ambulance units equipped with lower frame rigs just to get by. The Ambulance Corp is not only needed but is vital to

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our residents survival in time of health emergencies. The other issues that existed for over 8 year is the expansion of the Police Department. With the expansion by taking over the current ambulance location you can provide them with Salle Porte, Women's locker room, s training area, secured storage space for equipment, more offices & file storage. She would like the Mayor & Council strongly consider these needs before committing to a full scale rebuild of the bank building to create a new library. To address the library where is it is right now, a strategically planned multi-tired parking lot could address the main problem of the access to the library building. We already own the lot behind the building where such a parking lot could be built.

"AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 81 OF THE CODE ENTITLED "WATER AND WATER RATES" BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus that Chapter 81 of the code is hereby amended as follows:

### 81-21 Rates and Charges is amended as follows:

- (a) Effective January 1, 2024 all water taken or consumed shall be charged to consumers at the following rates:
  - (1) Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons, with a minimum charge of Sixty Dollars (\$64) per quarter, or any part thereof.
