Identify foam with this recycling symbol

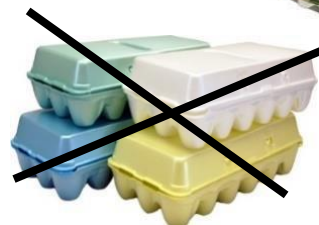


- Foam Sheets

Think Outside the Trash.....Recycle!

Items collected will prevent Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) waste, otherwise known as Styrofoam, from entering our landfills. Polystyrene is made to be protected from the elements, so when it ends up in a landfill, it will not break down and will just be a contributing factor to increased waste. While the exact lifespan of these products is unknown, scientists speculate it will take at least 500 years for polystyrene to break down, if it ever does at all.
