INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCES

ORDINANCE 2019-26

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 79 OF THE CODE OF HO-HO-KUS ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Ho-Ho-Kus, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that pursuant to Code Section 79-5, Schedule VI is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I

Schedule VI

The following described intersection is hereby designated as a Stop Intersection:

<u>Intersection</u> <u>Stop Sign On</u>

Cliff Street and First Street Cliff Street

All other provisions of Schedule VI not amended herein, remain in full force and effect.

Section II – Severability.

If any portion of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the provision directly involved in the

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controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section III - Repealer.

All other provisions of this chapter which are not affected by this ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect. However, all ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section IV – Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
